Gerald Daigle Memorial Scholarship

1. The scholarship is open to all individuals who either reside in Terrebonne Parish or whose parents, spouse, and/or legal guardian(s) reside in Terrebonne Parish.
2. The applicant must
 - a. maintain status as a full-time student as defined in the college catalog.
 - b. have maintained a minimum 2.6 grade point average.
 - c. have a desire to obtain a major or minor college degree in an arts-related field.
For the purpose of this scholarship, an arts-related field will include music, dance, communication arts, theatre, etc.
 - d. have attached a copy of high school/college transcripts to the application.
 - e. have completed the application in its entirety and included the required letters of recommendation.
3. The applicant may be requested to meet to discuss his/her application with a panel of judges.
4. The \$600 per year scholarship is paid in two equal payments upon receipt of proof of college registration.
5. A scholarship recipient may reapply for a following year or years upon completion of the renewal form and inclusion of a letter of recommendation (if he/she has maintained a cumulative minimum 2.6 grade point average in college).
6. All applications must be received no later than April 9, 2021.
7. The official presentation of the scholarship will be made at the annual awards banquet which is held in early June.
