5. Have completed a scholarship application and essay.
6. Have provided two letters of recommendation as per the application.

Special consideration will be given to Terrebonne Parish applicants, or applicants whose parents or guardians reside in Terrebonne Parish.

Applicants may be requested to meet with a panel of judges for an interview to discuss their application.

The \$1000 per annum is paid upon submission of proof of registration at Nicholls State University. A scholarship recipient may reapply for the following year.
