1. The scholarship is open to all high school seniors who either reside in Terrebonne Parish or whose parents, spouse, and/or legal guardian(s) reside in Terrebonne Parish.
2. For the purposes of this scholarship, an arts-related field will include music, dance, communication arts, theatre, culinary arts, etc.
3. The applicant must
  - a. maintain status as a full-time student as defined in the college catalog,
  - b. have maintained a minimum 2.6 grade point average,
  - c. have a desire to obtain a major or minor college degree in an arts-related field,
  - d. have attached a copy of high school/college transcripts to the application, and
  - e. have completed the application in its entirety and included the required letters of recommendation.
4. The applicant may be requested to meet to discuss his/her application with a panel of judges.
5. The \$600 per year scholarship is paid in two equal payments upon receipt of proof of college registration.
6. A scholarship recipient may reapply for a following year or years upon completion of the renewal form and inclusion of a letter of recommendation (if he/she has maintained a cumulative minimum 2.6 grade point average in college).
